Engine has four engine mounts, front, rear (under the steering rack), transmission and engine side. Support engine. Rear mount bolts. Front mount bolts. Mine was stuck in the bushing. Tranny mount will have to come off the fender to be lifted up. Engine side mount. Now everything is resting on the jack stands below

First, loosen the bolts that hold the mount to the engine by reaching down from above (you may need one or two long socket extension rods and a swivel joint). Then, remove the mount-to-frame bolts from under the vehicle. To get them fully out, you may need to raise the engine an inch or so.

Unclip the two clips on the air box on the right rear of the engine bay (red arrows). With the clips undone pull the box up and out (red arrow). On the right side strut tower you are going to remove one of the nuts and bolts (red arrow) and just loosen the other (yellow arrow).

After removing all three screws and the top nut, we then removed two screws from the lower front torque rod mount. This was a necessary step before we could lift the engine high enough to get the old rear engine mount out and the new one in. We then lifted the engine.

Once the engine and gearbox are on the ground, slowly roll the engine backwards to see if there are any fuel system components that will not clear the bottom of the rear bumper. If the rear bumper interferes you will have to decide if it is easier to remove the bumper or remove an easy to access component from the top of the fuel system to gain enough clearance to roll the engine out.

To remove the driveshaft you need to place the rear wheels onto ramp lifts to be able to get under the Bayou frame. The driveshaft is the long metal arm running the distance between the engine and the rear axle. You will need to remove the bolts that connect the driveshaft to the transmission and the rear axle to remove the driveshaft.

If there are no ventilation issues with the crankcase and the rear main has trouble sealing, you'll need to do an in-depth study of the area. Remove and disassemble the engine. Accurately measure the part of the crankshaft that rides on the seal. Torque the main cap in place with the seal installed, and check it for fit against the block.

I'm thinking I can remove the subframe by: 1) Removing the hood. 2) Jacking up the front of the car and setting it on jack stands at the front jack points. 3) Attaching the engine hoist to the engine/transmission assembly and lifting up just enough to take load of the engine & transmission off the rear mount. 4) Remove the cross member.

Remove the 4 U-joint bolts that hold the driveshaft to the rear differential. Then, using a small pry bar or screwdriver, pry the driveshaft forward to release it from the differential. Now, pull the driveshaft out of the transmission and set aside. Place the U-joint bolts and hardware in an appropriately marked container.

You need to remove the right front CV axle, remove the rear cat converter from underneath, the 3 screws in the motor mount heat shield then the top nut on the MM. Jack up the engine using a block of wood or from the top using the hooks. It's a pain in the rear to change. It took me a couple hours.
